

Ferret Rescue / Education Services

Rick and Ina Bechthold

Our speakers this week were Rick and Ina Bechthold from the Ferret Rescue and Education Society along with Willy and Fuzzy.

FRES is a non-profit charitable organization committed to the rescue and surrender of pet ferrets whose owners cannot take care of these animals due to illness, ageing or special needs.

Here are some things I learned about ferrets:

- they are meat eaters and so eat a high protein diet
- they need to run and play for 3 hours a day
- they have very inquisitive personalities
- they do have a scent gland but most are removed
- · ferrets can nip and bite just like kittens
- they are not mean and vicious as depicted on television
- there are no ferrets in the wild in Alberta
- they are related to the otter family so they have tiny webbed feet enabling them to swim
- they love sleeping and do so for 15-16 hours a day
- ferrets can have adrenal gland problems which mean expensive veterinary expenses

Welcome back Tom McKee our Summer Member from Florida!


Sunshine Harry Nazarchuk had no report -- that's good.

John Barratt shared the seven members having birthdays in June along with anniversaries. This month's total of combined years of married life is 193 ... WOW!


Jack Steen was recognized for being a great Chinook Rotary member. Congratulations Jack!
