# Climate Change Statistics Julia-Maria Becker, Pembina Institute

President David introduced today's speaker, Julia-Maria Becker, a senior analyst with the Pembina Institute.

Julia has worked for German and Mexican government institutions, attended the Paris climate negotiations as an observer, and is a member of Next Up's Climate Leadership Program.

The Pembina Institute is a non profit think tank that addresses clean environment ideas of how we can improve.

Climate change refers to wide spread change around the world in weather conditions. Human induced climate change increases greenhouse gases like carbon dioxide and methane when fossil fuels are burned.



Coal burning power plants produce a large amount of greenhouse gases. Some of these are being phased out and are scheduled to be closed in the future. Oil producing regions produce more greenhouse gases in their production process.

Some examples of energy efficiency savings for Albertans is to repair air leaks, increase insulation, upgrade home appliances, and change lighting to LED bulbs. There are many savings opportunities offered through Energy Efficiency Alberta.

President David thanked Julia for her presentation and closed the meeting at 1:30 pm.

May 23rd, 2017




























Anthony Tonkinson and Stephen Pick greeted our members and guests at today's meeting.


introduced our guests that included Hans Tiedemann from the South Club, and our guest speaker Julia-Maria Becker.

McLean's mother had just completed a surgery, and Ian Burgess had visited Barry Korpatniski following some back surgery.




