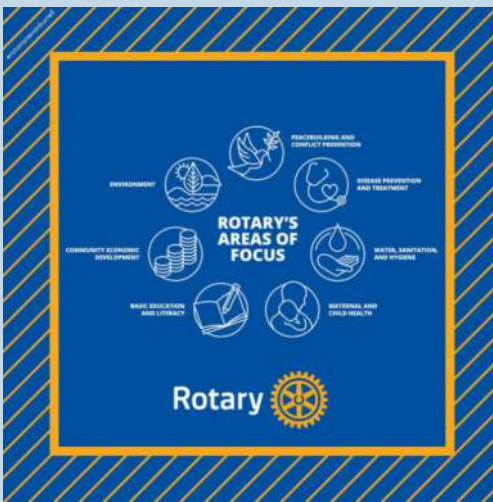

### OUR WINES and awards

Gourmet white wines designed to combine with refined dishes in restaurants. They are based on a good natural acidity that enhances and preserves a fresh and complex fruit. The rounded and long mouth came from keeping them in contact with fine yeasts for three months. In our Chardonnay, a blend of 50% of wine fermented in new American oak barrels with another 50% of wine fermented in stainless steel tanks is responsible of combining freshness and oak at a delicate balance.

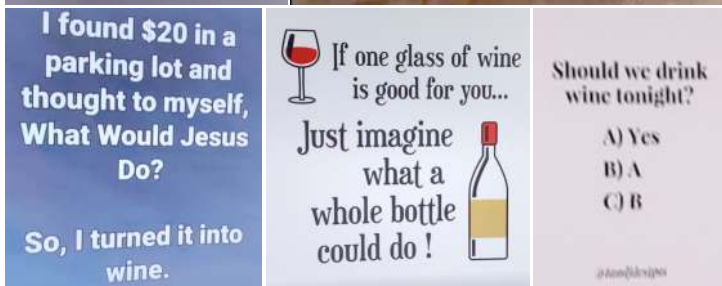
