The meeting began with O Canada. Past Prez Rob was in the chair, or rather he was standing in front of Rib Fest's "Billy's BBQ billboard".

Guests welcomed were Garfield Ganong, Ass't District Governor; and Karen M, from Rotary Employment Partnership.







Rob introduced our speaker, Andrew Reinhardt, owner of RibFest's Billy's BBQ. Andrew purchased the equipment 15 years ago from the previous Michigan owner — thus the reference to "best Michigan ribs". At age 20, he was the youngest owner/operator in Canada.

RibFest has been operating in Canada for 32 years. It began in Burlington, Ontario and since then has grown to 45 Rotary events in Canada during their 4 ½ months season. Since inception, approximately \$70 million has been raised by Rotary clubs. In 2021, there will be 16 shows in Alberta. For our event at McMahon stadium, there will be 4 rib teams. At a recent drive-thru- event in St. Albert, Rotary raised \$45k. Also this year, Fort St. John had 5000 vehicles go through.

Some of the biggest events have been in Ottawa with 20 rib teams, and Halifax with 7. Toronto clubs have raised \$3 ½ million over 14 years.

Prez George and Secretary Dale have met with the Carriage House regarding resumption of in person meetings. Info will be forwarded when dates are firmed up.


Next ZOOM meeting is August 3, when our DG Martin Parnell will join us.
