

In a couple of months, on August 8th, we will be having a picnic meeting in the assembly gazebo of our Nature Park, an annual tradition.

It is 23 years since we officially dedicated the Park by the Bow River, neighbouring the Mackenzie Meadows Golf Club. The property had been destined for expanded golf facilities of the golf course, on provincial lands under a long term lease. The golf course board paused the expansion when I pointed out that the land would be compromised because of utility rights of way, and may be shut down with as little as 30 days notice. The Board agreed that happening would be an economic nightmare. I suggested it might serve the public well as a Nature Park sponsored by Rotary. The government agreed and a new park was born, with me as CEO of the golf development overseeing the Nature Park. All design features and the new name were approved by Alberta Parks, and our club moved ahead with our signature footprint in Calgary's urban parks development. Aside



the abandoned gravel pit. Every year, at no charge to our club, the MMGC maintenance dept, under superintendent Wade Bishop, clears our trails, trims around the benches and gazebos, and the parking lot to get ready for summer visitors. MMGC Bar & Grill, under F & B Manager Paul McGowan, caters our picnic lunch in August, but goes way beyond just catering by providing tables and chairs and a staff member to oversee the service, all at no charge.

MMGC donated landscape loam, and the shaping and grading of
