Grants are not given to individuals for sponsorship, travel, awards, fellowships, scholarships or bursaries. Applicants must be registered charitable organizations. Recipients of grants will be expected to report back to the club on the expenditure of moneys granted and the completion of projects supported by the Rotary Club of Calgary Millennium.

We love to hear about the great work happening in our community. Before submitting a grant, please plan on attending one of our club meetings and tell us a bit more about your organization. If you submit a grant without meeting us first, unfortunately your request will not be considered.

When you are ready to submit a request for funding please include the following:

- 1. Name of organization
- 2. Copy of most recent audited financial statements
- 3. Project budget (please note our grants normally range in the amount of \$2,000-\$10,000 and are usually for one year only. Larger requests will be considered but will require at least 1 year lead time.
- 4. Specify how the funds will be allocated and used? Who else is funding the project?
- 5. When will the project be starting?
- 6. Which of our priority areas does this project support?
- 7. Do you have any opportunities for us to volunteer with your organization?
