

Rotary Club of Calgary Sarcee – 2024 Sir Winston Churchill High School Scholarship Program

Information:

The Rotary Club of Calgary Sarcee will offer the following scholarships to 2024 graduating students at Sir Winston Churchill High School:

- (1) Maximum of five Van Visvanatha Memorial Scholarships or Doug and Jean Fosbrooke Memorial Scholarships for \$2,000 each.
- (2) Maximum of three other scholarships for \$1,000 each.

Candidates are limited to one of the above scholarships.

The Van Visvanatha Memorial Scholarship is for candidates pursuing a career in engineering, environmental studies, or science.

The Doug and Jean Fosbrooke Memorial Scholarship is for candidates pursuing a career in business or the arts.

Students who do not qualify for the Van Visvanatha Memorial or Doug and Jean Fosbrooke scholarships may be considered for the other scholarships.

Each applicant that has met the eligibility criteria will be assessed individually on their background, experience, interest in their chosen field of study, and their commitment to helping others.

All recipients must either be entering a degree program at a recognized Canadian post-secondary institution, university, or college; or alternatively entering a Canadian technical institution, trade school, or apprenticeship program. The successful candidates will provide proof of registration in their program prior to receipt of scholarship. Scholarships will be paid directly to the institution to be applied towards tuition.

This scholarship is only open to Canadian Citizens and Permanent Residents.

Eligibility for Application:

- 1) Must be graduating students at Sir Winston Churchill High School.
- 2) Must be graduating in June and attending post-secondary institution or another approved program in the fall.
- 3) Must complete and submit application by May 31, 2024.
- 4) Must fully complete application and attach required documents.

Required Information:

- 1) Completed application form including approval by SWCHS Interact Club Teacher Sponsor or SWCHS Guidance Counsellor
- 2) Transcript of all high school marks (a Detailed Academic Report (DAR) is sufficient).
- 3) Copy of acceptance letter from chosen school or program.

4) Commitment to provide subsequent proof of attendance at chosen school or program.

2. Please provide a funding plan for the duration of your continuing education including tuition costs, costs of books and supplies, living costs, etc. as well as the planned source(s) of funds. (350 word limit)
3. If applying for the Doug and Jean Fosbrooke Memorial or Van Visvanatha Memorial scholarships, please tell us why you have chosen your intended field of study. Include any relevant information such as your background, experience, interest, etc. (350 word limit)
