

ISC has supported 2 projects with Ejo Youth Empowerment, a Rwandan charity set up by Umoja Community Mosaic of Calgary to replicate the highly successful Umoja programs in Rwanda. Notice in the video, the beautiful basketball court where the children are dancing. We helped make that happen. In the second part of the video, adults are clearing land for a water kiosk to be fed by a new hand dug water pipeline. We contributed approx. half of the cost towards that project. Excavation of the 5 km hand dug water pipeline is just starting.
