Global Grant Project: This project was just recognized in the Zone 25A meeting in Merida, MX. Jennifer Jones presented it to the lead Colombian Rotarians. Colombian District 4281 is the Host District with strong support from the Rotary Club of Nuevo Ibague. roughly 3200 Ponseti splints that will be loaned out to qualified clinics countrywide. These braces eliminate the need for almost all corrective surgeries for afflicted children. Rotary Club of Calgary at Stampede Park took the international lead. Supporting grants from other Calgary clubs made a big difference and helped reach a budget of CAD 176505




NEW MEMBER PROPOSAL
