1790 – January 8th was the first "State of the Union" address by President George Washington to the Congress. In it, he advocated for a Federal Post Office, Post roads, and a public education system.

1923 – Although Franklin Roosevelt is famous for his Depression era radio speech *"We have nothing to fear but fear itself"*, it was President Calvin Coolidge in 1923 that gave the first State of the Union address via radio.

1947 – On January 6th 1947, President Harry Truman delivers his State of the Union address for the first time on Television.

2023 – It is the U.S. Custom that at least one member of Cabinet not attend the State of the Union address in person, in the event a disaster wipes out the government. Our "Designated Survivor" today is PE Bryan Walton, who you can see is not present at the Head Table.
