#### The Cleven Award

We honour Harry Cleven by the Cleven Award. Harry held the position of our first Club President when we were formally known as the Manchester Rotary Club. When he wasn't serving on the board of directors for the YMCA or Rotary Club, he enjoyed Canoeing, and sang in the Chapter of the Barber Shoppers. He contributed actively to our city and club to make the world a better place. He lost his life in the crash of a Trans Canada Airlines flight on Mount Slesse near Chilliwack on December 9, 1956, along with 61 other individuals. Harry made many

positive contributions to the start-up foundation for our Rotary Club. Murray Flegel and Jim Burns share the title of the Cleven Award winners. We thank these Rotarians for their effortless contribution to helping others and living with the moto "Service Above Self." A 'Great Rotarian' is someone who goes above and beyond. Murray always gives this lable to others but deserves it himself. During Sheri Austin's speech, she reffered to him as 'The Coach.' Since joining in 2002 with our late friend Harris Dvorkin as his sponsor, he has made his way to Serving as our President in 2015-2016. Before his time with Rotary, he was a defenceman for multiple professional hockey teams. At the time he had a part time job at Texaco and it only went up for him from there on. Eventually, he founded his own company in 1992, Boss Lubrications. He works closely with his family and we are thankful that the Flegel's are a well known name around the Rotary House! They have hosted multiple exchange students and are heavily involved in the club. Murray is known as a do-er. When the Rotary sign was broken, He fixed it without hesitation. Fellowship is a cornerstone of Rotary, and a good Rotarian fosters a sense of camaraderie and friendship within their club. They actively engage with fellow Rotarians, forging connections that extend beyond the confines of meetings and projects. Murrays fellowship not only strengthened the Rotary community but also enhances the collective ability to make a meaningful impact. We loved hearing all your stories.
