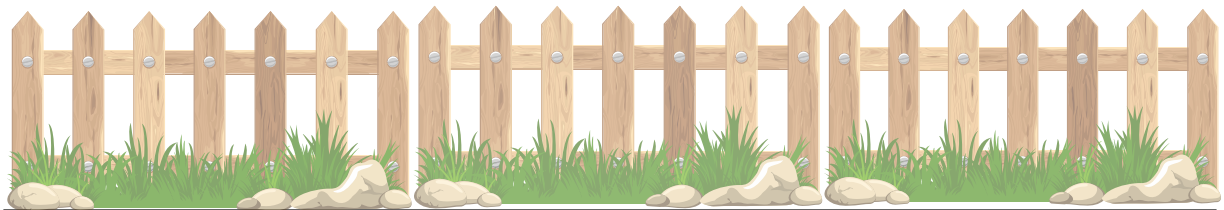

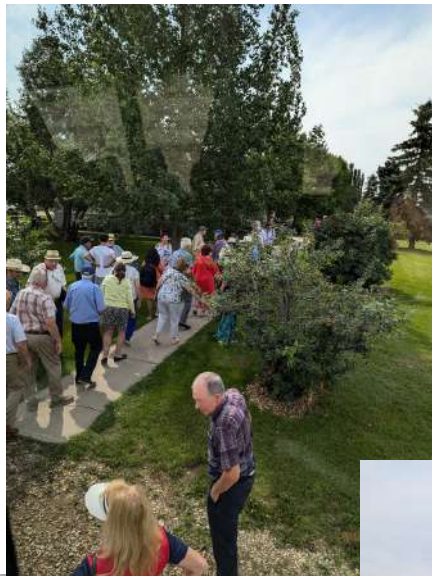


# Today's Meeting:

Paul M Wipf, Viking, AB, Canada. Paul is an elder and the Farm Steward who supervises the Cropland and the Viking Hutterite Colony. Married to Martha with five children and blessed with 22 grandchildren, Paul has an interest in preserving and sharing Hutterite history and culture. In 2000 he toured Belgium, France, Italy, Austria, and Germany in search of the birthplace of the Anabaptists and their ancestral faith.

Paul has presented Hutterite History, Faith, and Culture presentations to TD Bank, Meyers Norris and Penny, Farmtech 2009 and 2010, NRCB, NAIT, Olds College, the 17th annual Believers church conference at Acadia University NS, and numerous Church throughout Canada.

Paul's presentation was a small open window into the Hutterite Society allowing the viewer to see the Hutterites in operation revealing a way of life that seems extraordinary to the outside world. Paul shared the Birth of The Hutterite Society, Historic residence, Education, Language, Cultural traditions, Managerial Structure, Courtship and Marriage, Colony Expansion, Hutterite Surnames, Different Groups, and Successes and Challenges that colonies face today.

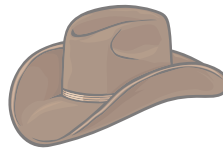
