On November 11 over 230 Rotarians and guests joined together to recognize and thank the veterans whose service has ensured the freedoms we enjoy today.

The memorial began with DG Christina Hassan bringing greetings from Rotary and asking those in attendance to take a moment to reflect on Reconciliation. Christina was followed by "Oh Canada" and the invocation from Salvation Army Rev. Maj. Harold Aitkenhead.

This year's Rotary Remembers was fortunate to have three outstanding speakers.

Dr. Alana Gowdy shared her work of fiction based on a true story about a Canadian soldier protecting a French family in the middle of the Battle of Normandy.

Major (Ret) Bruce Henwood spoke about his experiences as a disabled veteran and his successful fight to ensure that disabled veterans receive proper care and support, something that, unfortunately, was lacking.

Finally, Major (Ret) Bob Wade shared some of the many interesting and humorous stories from his days as a fighter pilot in the RCAF. As this year is the 100 th anniversary of the RCAF, Major Wade provided a history and his view toward the future of the RCAF.

President **Jim** presented the Honour Roll recognizing the service of both the living and deceased members of the Rotary Club at Calgary Stampede Park as did the presidents of the other clubs in Calgary.

From the External Communications Committee

Earlier in September we had a notice in the Bulletin that the Club was planning on refreshing Rotary House including the Display Cases in the reception area. This project was taken on by the External Communication's Committee headed by Janet Matthews and **Dilan Perera**. We are pleased to announce that the Rotary House Upgrade project and budget have been approved by the Board. The Stampede in-house carpenters will be starting on the project, including the upgrading of the Display cases, in the coming weeks. The new cases will include many storyboards of the history of Rotary, our Club, and many of our projects. The Past President's photos have been removed from the cases and are now mounted in large multi-photo frames to go into the refurbished cases. In the next couple of weeks all the other pictures, memorabilia, and trophies will be moved to the Rotary office to be reused or stored as appropriate. If anyone can take anything they need at the next three meetings before Christmas, such as trophies and awards, it would be helpful. The nameplates in the Paul Harris and CRCF displays are the responsibility of the Foundations Committee. They are being replaced with more modern Boards. There will be no change to the recorded names, but the CRCF Board will have a much better layout. We have over 600 PHF name plates and rather than throwing them out we will save those of current members, their families, and friends and take them to the office. If you would like to have any of these, they will be available starting next week at the front desk, but only until the end of December.
