John Hickie from the Millennium Club came up to tell us about "Gino A child of war" Please see more info on page 4 or watch the meeting video linked on page 1.







OCTOBER 11 at 7PM at The Globe Theatre in Calgary

This is the true story of Gino Farnetti-Bragaglia, a <u>5-year old</u> Italian orphan, adopted by Canadian soldiers during World War Two. Some of the filming was on-site in Italy, with other shooting venues in Calgary and post-production work in Calgary. The film runs about 55 minutes, and my friend, Karen Storwick, a military historian and the <u>films</u> producer, will provide a question-and-answer session immediately afterwards.

We're presenting the film in conjunction with History Matters, a registered charity that works to preserve stories of Canada's Armed Forces. Costs of presenting the film and proceeds are shared by Rotary Club of Calgary Millennium and History Matters.

Board Resolution unanimously recommended by the Legacy and Stampede Liaison Committees and approved unanimously by the Board of Directors:

In recognition of the long-term relationship and collaborative partnership the Rotary Club of Calgary at Stampede Park has shared with the Calgary Stampede, the Board resolves to establish a designated fund in the Rotary Club of Calgary at Stampede Park Community Service Fund, a registered charity. The purpose of the Designated Fund is to accumulate receipts from donors, bearing the notation "Stampede Designated Fund", with the goal of accumulating \$250,000 by December 31, 2025. Once \$250,000 has been accumulated, the balance in the "Stampede Designated Fund" will be donated to The Calgary Stampede Foundation and the "Stampede Designated Fund" will be closed.

As presented at the meeting of the Rotary Club of Calgary at Stampede Park on October 2, 2025:

- Any amount donated to the Designated Fund is welcome.
- Our Club will establish a Donor Wall in our new Rotary House to recognize donors contributing \$1000 or more.
- E-transfers and cheques are acceptable.
- E-transfers need to be sent to <u>Donations@rotarycs.org</u>. Notation should be made that they are to be applied to the Stampede Designated Fund.
- Cheques should be made payable to Rotary Club of Calgary at Stampede Park. They should bear the notation, for "Stampede Designated Fund".
