

President Al shared the Springbank Community magazine where our Club was thanked for them receiving funds through our small grants committee.


# A Merry Christmas Social Gathering ...







This week I went to a Christmas party with my host parents. In the party, I met some new friends, some of them are even in my school. The dinner is really


