ROTARY REMEMBERS GUEST SPEAKER: MAJOR JAMIE MILLER

Rotarian Garry Miller introduced our Guest Speaker, his son Major Jamie Miller. Major Miller joined the military in 1985 as a naval officer and in 1988 was posted to his first assignment on the H.M.C. Assiniboine. In 1991 he graduated from the Canadian Forces Fleet School as a Director of Underwater Warfare and was



posted on the H.M.C. Huron in 1992 in the pacific.

Major Miller then went to the Intelligence Branch as an officer with 2 tours of duty in 1992 and 1997. He was released from the Canadian Forces in 1997 and returned to military service in 2003 as a Senior Intelligence Officer assigned to the air force. He served as a Future Capability Officer and Intelligence Analyst during the Afghan mission. In August 2012 he was posted with the National Geospatial Intelligence Agency


Major Miller gave a very informative presentation on the current state of the war in the Middle East. He spoke in detail about what the real problems and risks that ISIL is creating in Iraq. Major Miller advised us that Canada's Military is very highly regarded around the world and especially with the U.S. and Great Britain.
