Los Amigos Project

Mexico

- A project (initiated through Lethbridge Sunrise Rotary Club) that coordinates the donation of decommissioned Canadian vehicles to Mexico communities
- Vehicles are in regular use for emergencies, fire fighting or transportation of young students and disabled individuals in México
- An advanced training program, delivered in Mazatlan, helps emergency medical technicians and fire fighters develop their skills
- Supplies accompany the vehicles to help support the local communities
- Each vehicle requires \$8000 to transport – however supporting Clubs are asked to contribute what they can
- The convoy travels April 16 – May 1, 2016

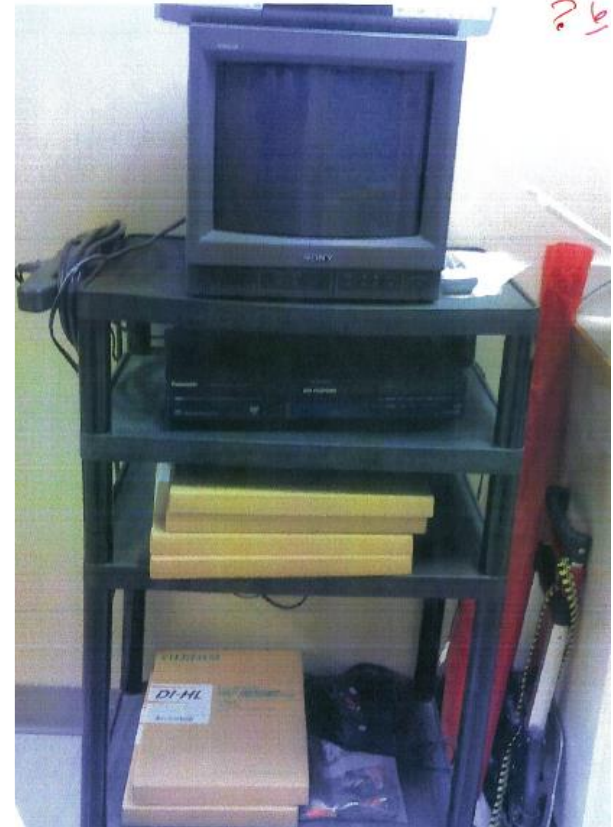
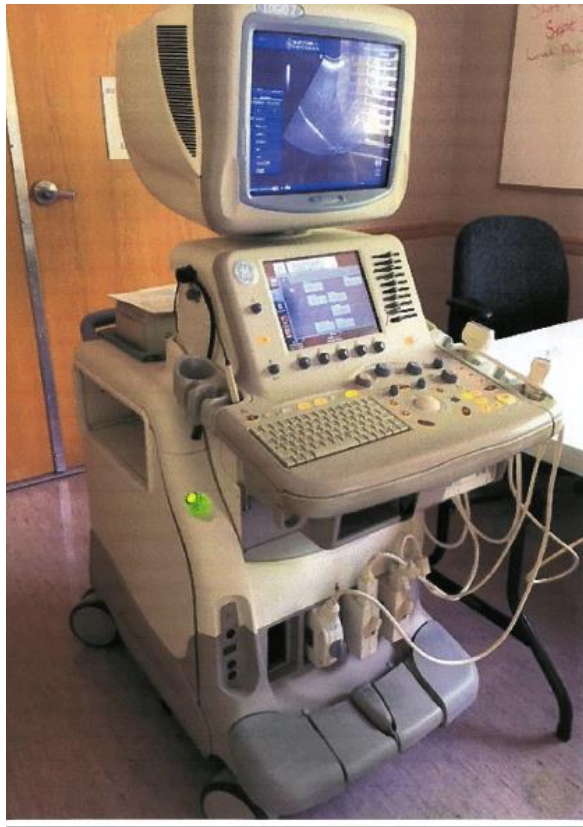
