DID YOU KNOW?
 The Rotary Sundial outside City Hall was a gift to the community from the Rotary Club of Medicine Hat in 1968 upon celebrating the club's 50th anniversary. There were only two sundials in North America at that time.

Initially installed in June 1969, the Sundial (or Sun Clock as it is sometimes called) is 6 feet 9 inches in diameter, made of pink granite, and weighs 3450 pounds. Its first location was at the Medicine Hat Museum and Art Gallery, just off the Trans-Canada Highway. The Sundial was moved to its current location in front of the Medicine Hat City Hall during the 1980s.
