Application Process:

A member in good standing of our club must "sponsor" you for membership. The process is as follows:

- 1. You attend at least three club meetings
- You complete the application form (attached) and submit it (designate information to be included)
- 3. The Board of Directors will review your application and will announce to the Club, through the weekly newsletter.
- 4. After two weeks without objection, you will be invited to become a member. You will receive information that will provide you with an overview about Rotary at the Club, District and International levels.
- A formal induction ceremony will take place at the next club meeting, where you receive your official welcome to the Club, along with name badge, Rotary pin, etc. Your dues will be payable the day of your induction.
- The Membership Committee also has social events to help you become better acquainted with your new friends at Rotary.
