This is a Rotary sponsored program that builds schools, provides scholarships, and works with the Department of Education in Guatemala, one of the poorest countries in the western hemisphere.

This year's ride will be **The Floyd Manz Memorial Ride** in honour of **Floyd Manz** who passed away as the result a motorcycle accident on June 18, 2021. Floyd was a member of the Rotary Club of Regina and rode in our Ripple Effect Ride for 6 years, beginning in 2015. During that time he raised \$14,384.

We will miss Floyd! He was a very kind, pleasant and friendly man, with a deep commitment to helping others, and a dedication to making this world a better place.

The Ripple Effect Program is committed to fighting poverty and promoting world peace by enhancing educational opportunities and the level of instruction for children living in challenging environments. The program focuses on kindergarten to grade 6 and scholarships for Middle and High School students. We have been working in Guatemala since 1999 and have built or refurbished nearly 100 schools.
