

Sagimay Trail Phase 1 Enhancement

To make the Trail Barrier Free for Everyone

Background and Project Information

- The intention of the project is to upgrade the Sagimay trail loop that is currently has a soft wood chip surfacing, to a barrier-free compacted limestone pathway. This is Phase 1 of a longer-term project. The remainder of the trail to be upgraded in 2025.
- The forest is considered a natural area and has special provisions as determined by the City Naturalists. City Naturalist to provide regular review of work area.
- Construction access will be limited to the footprint of the pathway being upgraded. Minimal clearing and grubbing is expected.

Scope of Work

Scope work to be completed under the Contract shall consist of:

- Level existing wood chip pathway and organic material.
- Supply and Installation of compacted limestone pathway, and geogrid along existing pathway alignment.
- Supply and Installation of sub surface drainage below path in low lying areas.

Site Access

- Public access into Assiniboine Forest from Grant and Chalfont entry is to be maintained.
- Contractor to provide flag persons for movement of equipment within publicly accessed areas, or provide safe detour.
- The area of construction of the pathway is to be closed to the public throughout the duration of construction. Contractor to supply, erect and maintain trail closure signage. Contractor to make safe work site at the end of the day.

Owner

The owner of the land is the City of Winnipeg.
