We are happy to offer a virtual event this year for the youth in our district.

eRYLA 2020: Empowering Young People of Action will be an 3-Day online program for youth aged 12-22. Participants will have an opportunity to hear from speakers from all over the country. Each day will start with a Rotary related keynote, followed by two leadership sessions with breakout groups in between to facilitate discussions and networking, and each day will run from 9:30-12:30 CST.

This is not a 'choose one day' event. Participants who register must attend all three days to receive a certificate of completion. Any handouts and contact information for presenters will be sent to participants at the end of the three days.

We will be using the zoom platform, so participants must have the program downloaded and ready to go before the start of the event. After September 9th, we will still be accepting registrations, however, they may not be guaranteed a seat. If clubs can arrange for more than one participant to use one 'seat' (two siblings, a small group of socially distanced participants using one computer, etc.), then we may be able to accommodate more people. Regardless, each INDIVIDUAL must fill in a registration form so that we have the necessary contact information.
