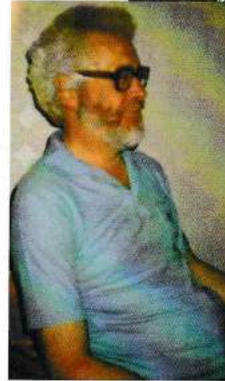

Nutana Rotary Anns

An organizational meeting was held on November 1, 1961. At the first meeting, Loreen McKay outlined the purpose and objectives of Rotary and a decision was made that the wives of the Rotarians would form their own group, called Rotary Anns, and that it would be a purely social group, assisting the Rotarians in their projects, only if asked.

Some of the activities the Rotary Anns engaged in were membership teas, coffee parties, or dessert parties at which new members were introduced. Rotary Anns also organized the annual Christmas party and supper get-togethers during which they, along with the exchange student, cooked a traditional meal from the student's home country.

The name of Rotary Anns changed to Rotary Partners in later years. In 1990, the year women were invited to join Rotary, Rotary Partners became unnecessary as a separate group. The partners could now become Rotarians if they so chose.

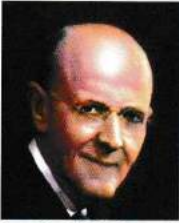

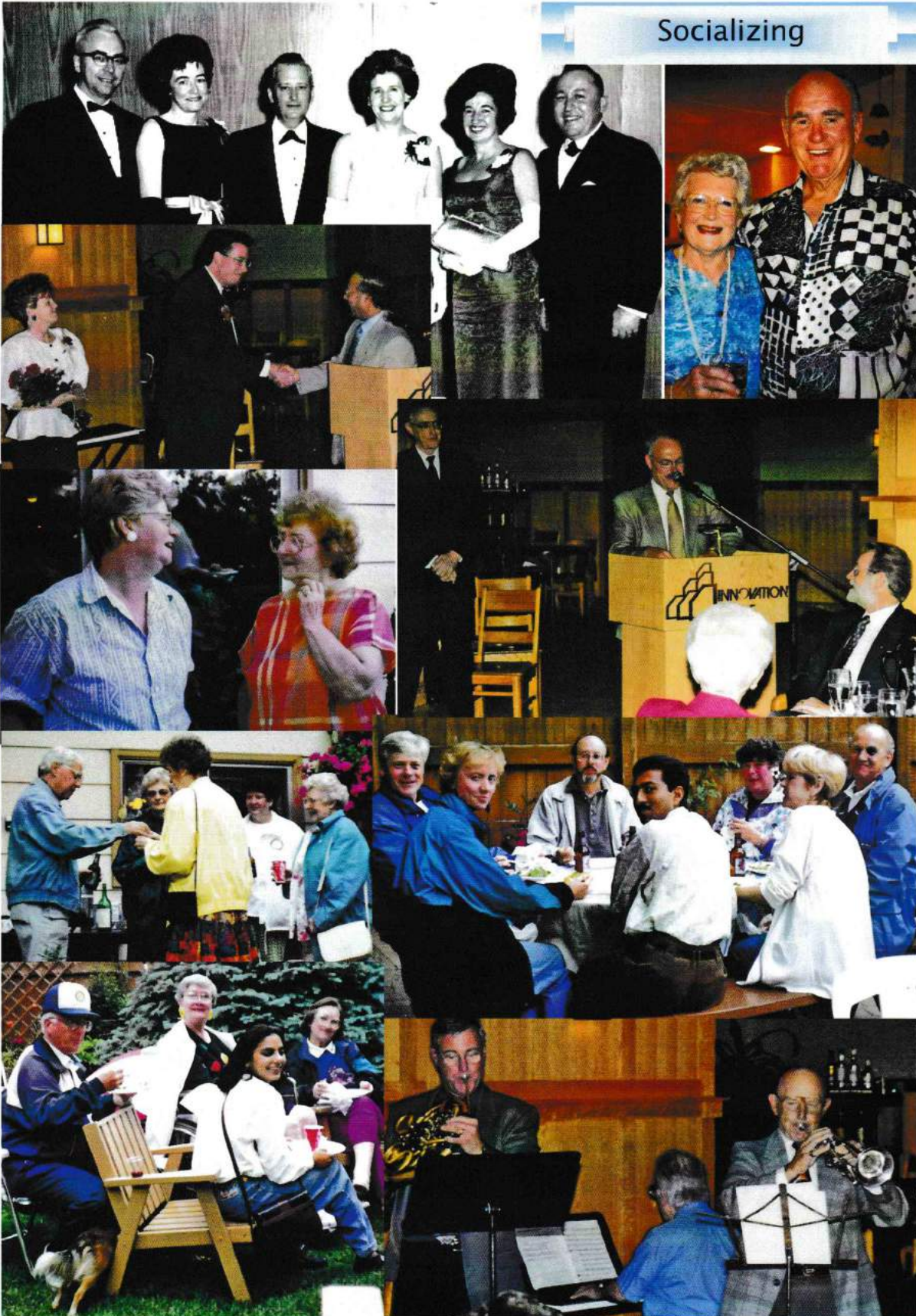

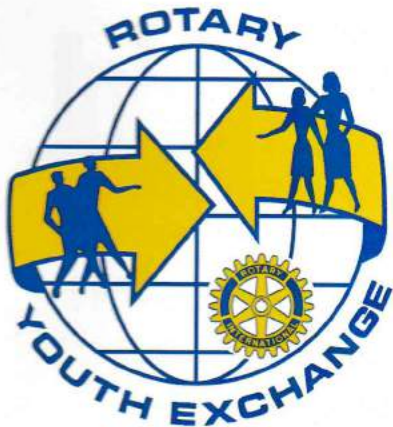

Rotary Youth Exchange Program

Youth exchange was started in 1974 when Saskatoon Nutana hosted the first exchange student, Narelle Kirkwook, from Sydney, Australia. Ed Hegel acted as her counsellor. This was also the start of the district program.

Barbara Armstrong was selected as the first outbound student for the 1975-76 Rotary year. In 2004 her daughter was selected as an exchange student thus extending the program into the second generation.

The program increased to two students (Jane Arscott to Belgium and Kay Larsen to Australia) in 1976-77, both sponsored by Nutana. For the next 12 years after that, Nutana sponsored two students each year and one student per year thereafter.

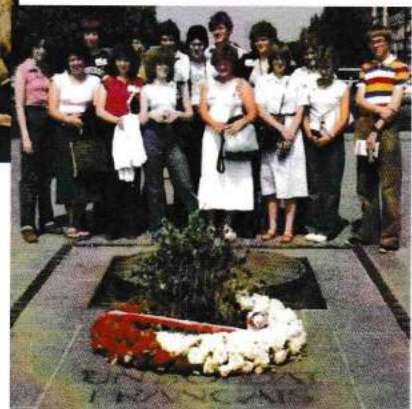
Ed Hegel acted as club chair for the youth exchange program and district chair until 1980 when he became District Governor. The district program had increased to 25 outbound student at that time.

Saskatoon Nutana Rotary has sponsored some 50 students out of approximately 150 students sponsored by all the Saskatoon clubs since 1975. To date, the district has sponsored approximately 1,000 students in 30 years.

Short Term Youth Exchange

The short term program was launched in the summer of 1979 as a pilot project when Ed and Alice Hegel accompanied 15 Saskatoon students for a month exchange with Germany and returning from Germany at the end of July with 15 Saskatoon students and 15 German students.

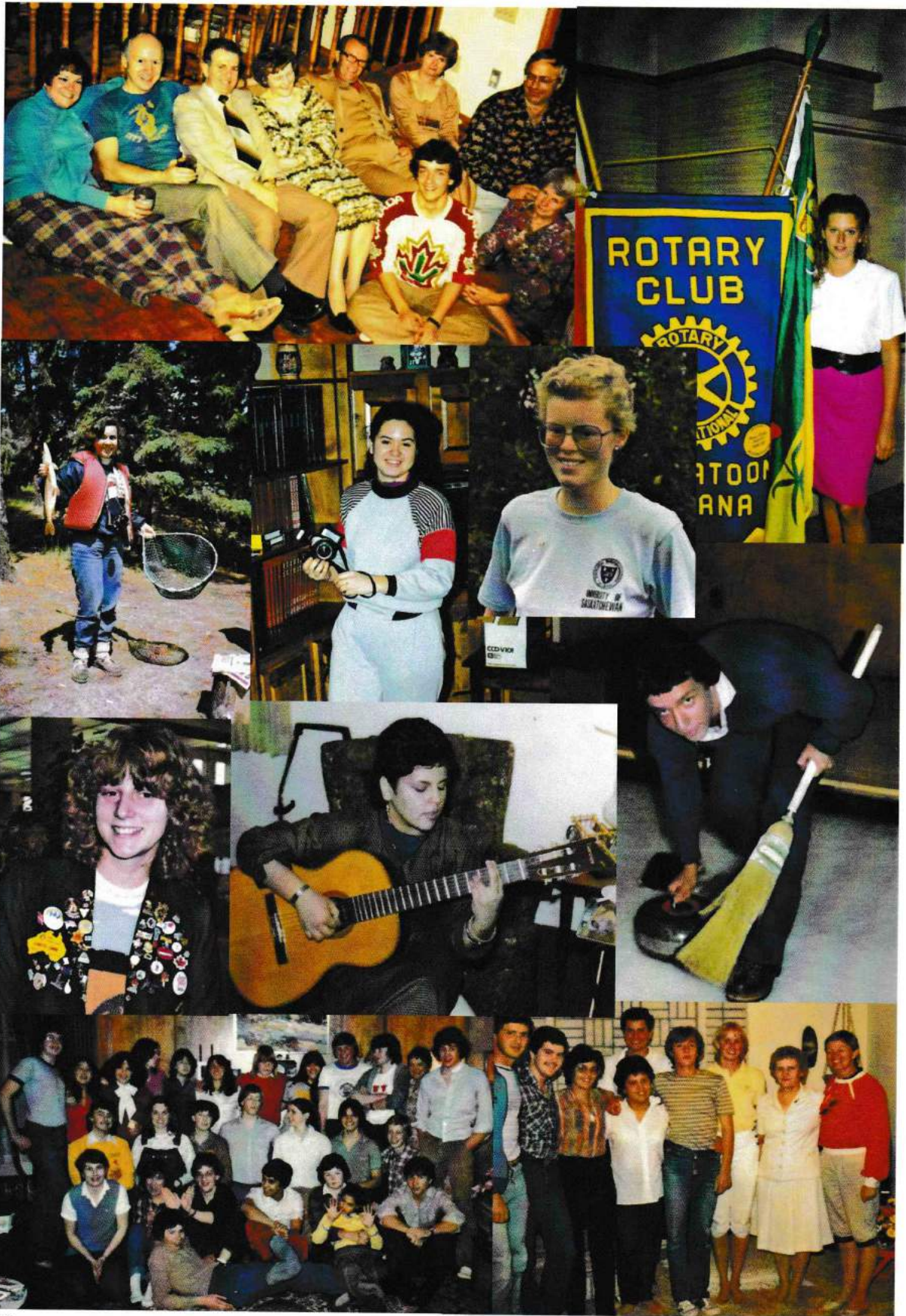

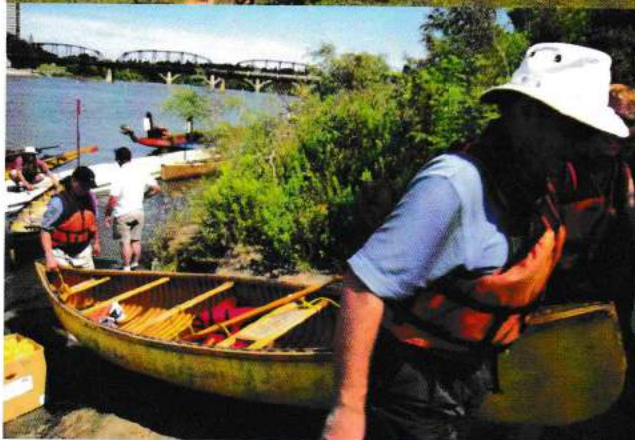
- Citizenship Court. Plan and arrange for a citizenship court for new Canadians - started by Herb Clark in 1968.
