Program - Lynne Caldwell - Adele House



Peggy Clark introduced Lynne Caldwell of Adele House, a residence for women fleeing domestic violence. Adele House is the second stage of support provided by Interval House, which accepts women and their children for short term stays. Residents can live in one of the 12 suites at Adele House for up to a year. During this time, Lynne and other staff members help the women learn how to live a different life, free of domestic violence. Lynne said Saskatchewan is the worst province for domestic violence and also the worst for women to be murdered by their ex-partner after leaving a violent situation. Such facts show the important role Interval House and Adele House provide by offering a safe place for women in that situation. During their time at Adele House, Lynne often witnesses an incredible transition among the women and their children who often emerge stronger and ready to face the world.
