Program - Murray Totland - Solair by Arbutus



Norm Woodcock introduced Murray Totland, who worked for 36 years for the City of Saskatoon, ending up as City Manager. Murray now works for Arbutus Properties which is developing The Meadows neighborhood in east Saskatoon and is planning an innovative new development named Solair a bit farther east. Solair will be a community unique in Canada and maybe even all of North America. Key factors will be the production of electricity through solar panels on all the rooftops and handling of runoff through bio-swales or rain gardens rather than large storm sewers. All homes and other buildings will be built to a high standard of energy efficiency. The creation of electricity through solar power will lead to a reduction of 455,000 tonnes of greenhouse gases over 25 years, when compared to conventional neighborhoods of similar size. The neighborhood will be designed on the grid system which is most efficient in terms of land use and delivery of utilities. Murray hopes that phase 1 will begin in 2020.
