## Program - Trevor Davies - Air Cadets



Norm Woodcock introduced Captain Trevor Davies, Commanding Officer of the Air Cadets No. 574 Dakota Squadron, based in Martensville. This is the group that does such a great job of keeping our RibFest grounds neat and tidy. Trevor described the Air Cadets program, which provides young people aged 12-18 with opportunities to learn about flying and gliding; survival and field craft; marksmanship; and community service. Air Cadets gain life skills such as leadership, responsibility, self-discipline and confidence. Remarkably, there is no cost to the participating youth, but they must participate in fundraising activities, such as the RibFest cleanup. The Dakota Squadron needs to raise about \$30,000 annually to support its programs. Jack Scott thanked Trevor for his presentation.
