Program - Erika Quiring - Saskatoon Farmers' Market



Bryan Tastad introduced Erika Quiring, Executive Director of the Saskatoon Farmers' Market (SFM). Erika recounted some of the organization's history including its founding as Toad Lane Farmers' Market in 1975, its move to the Riversdale location in 2007, and its latest move to Koyle Avenue near the airport in December 2019. Through it all, SFM has continued to be a producer owned co-operative with the purpose of providing consumers with products grown or produced locally. SFM has had encouraging results so far at its new location, which is open Saturdays and Sundays. Its plans for Koyle Avenue include renovations of the main indoor concession area, creation of a commercial kitchen for vendor and public use, and development of outdoor seasonal vendor space. In the summer SFM will offer satellite markets downtown on Wednesdays and at Lakewood Civic Centre on Thursdays. SFM is also looking at forming a partnership with the University of Saskatchewan to develop a agricultural business incubator on land north of the city.
