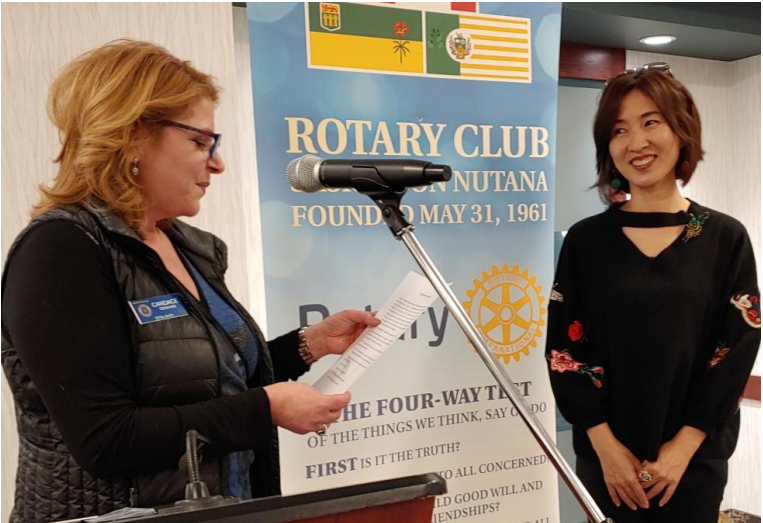
Program - Satellite Club
