**Program - Marlea Whitley and Amanda McReynolds Doran - Nutrien Wonderhub**

Bryan Tastad introduced Marlea Whitley, Development Manager, and Amanda McReynolds Doran, Executive Director, of the Nutrien Wonderhub, which has been operating in the former Mendel Art Gallery Building on Spadina since June 2019. Amanda traced the development of the Wonderhub over the past 20 or more years under the leadership of very dedicated volunteers. For a while it operated in a mini bus, then found a 1,200 square foot space in Market Mall. The construction of the

new Remail Modern Art Gallery create a wonderful opportunity to take over the former Mendel Art Gallery Building, which is about 10 times the size of the Children's Discovery Centre in Market Mall. Over the first seven months attendance has been 116,000, which far exceeds the expected 60,000 visits per year. The Wonderhub was carefully designed to help children up to age 12 learn through play. Amanda and Marlea took us on a tour, which left many of us wanting to spend more time there. Marlea asked our club to consider participating in the sponsorship of one of six free days during the year. Such a sponsorship would cost \$7,500 and could be done in partnership with the other Rotary Clubs in the city. (Amanda is a member of the Rotary Club of Saskatoon North so there would be a good advocate there). As a sign of our support we donated the change from our soup and sandwich meal, which amounted to \$101.
