**Program** - David Neufeld - Ancient Echoes Interpretive Centre

Bryan Tastad introduced David Neufeld, one of the leaders of the Ancient Echoes Interpretive Centre near Herschel. The centre, located in the former school, is nestled at the junction of the Coalmine Ravine and the Eagle Creek and offers both indoor and outdoor tours of Paleontology sites (dinosaur and fossil displays and dig), Prairie Grasslands Ecology (virgin prairie medicine and food plants, animals in the wild and taxidermy displays), and First Nations History (petroglyphs, rock formations, effigies, archaeological dig, teepee rings, buffalo jump, food processing site, tool artifacts and pottery making displays). A permanent art exhibition by Metis artist, Jo Cooper, expresses a visual and oral story with "The Disappearance and Resurgence of the Buffalo". Additionally, sculptures outside the centre stimulate the imagination as well as humour. Ancient Echoes operates from May 7th to August 31st Tuesdays-Sundays from 9:00 AM - 5:00 PM (closed Mondays). The Valley View Tea Room is open every Friday from 2:30-4:30 PM in May and every Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday from 2:30-4:30 PM from June-August. A retreat centre is also located nearby.
