#### **Program - Michael Gramiak - Western Canada Summer Games**



Michael Gramiak spoke about his

role as a member of the soccer coaching staff for the Western Canada Summer Games, to be held in Swift Current from August 9-18, 2019. Over 1,700 athletes, coaches, officials and mission staff from Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba, Northwest Territories, Yukon and Nunavut will be attending the 10 days of competition. These athletes, ages 13 – 20 years old, are our country's next generation of national, international, Olympic and Paralympic champions. Michael said the soccer team has developed a program of setting audacious goals, "failing forward," then setting even more audacious goals. The aim is to take Saskatchewan from its traditional role in the middle of the pack to the forefront of national competition. President Stan thanked Michael for his presentation.
