Program - Will Grant - This is My Life



Norm Woodcock introduced Will Grant, one of our newest members, who gave a brief outline of his life's journey so far. Will lost his father at an early age and his mother subsequently suffered from depression. This resulted in Will being "scooped" and spending years in foster homes. He lived in multiple foster homes and attended 11 different elementary schools while growing up. One of his elementary school teachers went "above and beyond." Will excelled at basketball and received an award upon graduating. Will went to E. D. Feehan and then Mount Royal High Schools. He played football and was scouted by the Hilltops and Huskies. At the same time he began experimenting with life and developed an interest in acting. He enrolled at the U of S in the Drama program but later switched to social work. He has been working at the Saskatoon Indian Métis Friendship Centre for about one year. Will bears no grudge against the government for being scooped and recognizes that the social workers were really trying to do the best for him. Indeed, his experience with social workers is what led him to choose social work as a career. He asked Rotarians to come out to the Friendship Centre and be involved.
