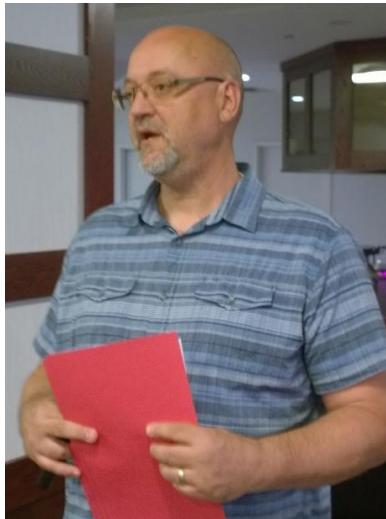

### **Program - RibFest Preparations**



Boris Kishchuk led a discussion of preparations for Saskatoon Rotary RibFest to be held August 2-5 at Rotary Park. Scott Delahey of SLGA, pictured, joined the discussion to emphasize a few points related to the liquor license. Some of the points noted were:

- The main concerns are underage drinkers, intoxicated people being served more drinks, and liquor leaving the licensed area;
- All Rotarians are part of the security team. You must not drink alcohol before or during your security shift;
- Drinks are not allowed in the children's area;
- Identification should be checked when liquor tickets are purchased, but bartenders should also feel free to ask for i.d. as the tickets may be passed on to underage people;
