#### Program - Preet Jain - Welcome to Canada

Stan Garchinski introduced Preet Jain, a young man from India now studying at the U of S. When Preet was planning to come to Canada, he had no contacts to help him get settled. His father Vikram, a Rotarian, emailed Stan, who was then president of our club, for help. Stan met Preet at the airport in January 2019, hosted him for the the first night, oriented him to the city, and maintained contact over the 15 months since he arrived. Preet spoke to the club about his impressions of Canada and the reception he has received. Some of his points were:

- Canadian cars have the driver's seat on the left hand side.
- Canadians are kind. Thanks to Stan for his hospitality!

- Canadians can be rude. They ask "how's your day going?" but don't stop to hear the answer.
- Canadians get their caffeine fixes at Tim Horton's. In India, people go to the tea stalls.
- Canada is almost a cash free society while India still uses mostly cash.
- Canadian buses are very clean and empty compared to those in India. They have no conductor so Preet didn't know how to stop the bus on his first trip.
- In India it is common to know every family in your apartment building but in Canada you may not know any of your neighbors.
- In India young people stay in their family home until they finish their education or get a job but Canadians often move out at a young age.
- Canadians don't care for much spice in their food. Also, many more people in India are vegetarians.
- Canadian health care is amazing!
- No one takes attendance at university in Canada, whereas in India your attendance is counted as part of your grade.
- All countries have different cultures and all should be appreciated!

Following Preet's presentation, his father Vikram talked about his Rotary club's projects which include an annual marathon. He wondered whether our clubs could work together on a water conservation project. President Candace thanked Preet and Vikram on behalf of the club.
