Program - Michael Gramiak - This is My Life



President Walt introduced new member Michael Gramiak, the grandson of Bill Christensen. Michael spoke about his birth in Saskatoon in 1992, a family split and a move to Okotoks, Alberta in childhood, and a return to Saskatoon in 2010 to attend university. Michael ran with the U of S cross country team while he pursued his classes in political studies, with a major in public policy. He then took a second degree in education. While still in school Michael started coaching with Eastside Soccer, which ultimately led to a career opportunity as Eastside Soccer's Technical Director. Although he has never held a regular classroom position, Michael's position with Eastside Soccer involves plenty of teaching. He has upgraded his coaching certification to the point where he is now active at the regional and national levels. He is developing unique coaching methods that are based on encouraging self-discovery rather than teaching by rote. His philosophy is to build better people through sport and has seen how important sports can be in helping new Canadians feel involved and welcomed. Michael tries to work with the whole family rather than just the soccer player. President Walt thanked Michael for his inspiring presentation.
