**Program - Toby Esterby - Camponi Housing Corp.**



Randy Kutcher introduced Toby Esterby, Executive Director of Camponi Housing Corp. Toby described the growth of the organization from its founding as the Native Alcohol Centre in 1973, to restructuring as Sasknative Rentals in 1974, and Camponi Housing Corporation in the 1980s. The founding directors were Ron Camponi, Tony Camponi, Nora Thibodeau Cummings, Clarence Trotchie and Bill Wardell. Bill Wardell, who is Jim Gillis' law partner, continues to serve with the organization. Camponi works to address Saskatoon's need for affordable housing, especially for Métis and First Nations people. It now owns more than 400 residences with a workforce that varies from 15-25. Camponi has learned that the provision of tenant services helps to create stable communities. Its latest project is Edwards Manor, a converted apartment building that accommodates tenants who are among the most difficult to house. On-site staff are available to help with issues that may arise. The corporation is selling off some its original properties to raise funds for a new community that will combine a variety of types of housing along with community services. 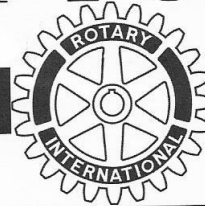
