Lorne Braithwaite introduced Malba Holliday, Executive Director, and Heather Hedstrom, Donor and Community Relations Advisor of the Salvation Army. Malba and Heather described the history of the Salvation Army and the many services that it provides in Saskatoon and throughout Saskatchewan. The Salvation Army is Canada's largest NGO providing direct social services and it ranks among the top 25 Canadian charities. In Saskatoon the organization provides a number of residential facilities, including the men's shelter on Avenue C, Mumford House for women, and Bethany Home for teenage girls, in addition to many other programs. Malba and Heather thanked our club for our ongoing involvement in the Christmas Kettles fundraiser. This year a total of \$339,000 was raised in the city. A volunteer appreciation event will be held on April 25. Asit Sarkar expressed the club's thanks.
