### Announcements & Program Highlights

President Lorne called the meeting to order at noon and welcomed all members present as well as guest Darren Fradette.

Lorne thanked all the members contributing to the meeting this afternoon.

- Will Grant noted that the SIMFC outreach vans with the Rotary logo were handing out popsicles during the recent hot spell.

• Lorne spoke about the Sioux Lookout clubs project of collecting used eyeglasses. The Saskatoon club participated in the collection. The eyeglasses are used in Peru and distributed by a van that circulates in the rural area. The project was awarded a global grant and also coordinates required eye surgeries

## <u>Program</u>

The program consisted of cheques being presented to the St. Francis Cree Bilingual School and Saskatoon Indian Metis Friendship Centre to assist in the funding of their respective food programs.

St Francis Cree Bilingual School is part of the Catholic school board system and houses approximately 600 students on two campus. Our club has a long standing relationship with this school, previously helping with the purchase of tablets. Lorne presented a cheque of \$1000 to Principal Darren Fradette for their breakfast/lunch/snacks program. Darren expressed his appreciation for the cheque and for the relationship with Nutana Rotary Club. Darren noted that to date Nutana Rotary has provided \$44,000 in funding support to the school. The budget for the food program at the school is \$72,000 and every cent is spent. Approximately 60% of the students participate.

Saskatchewan Indian Metis Friendship Centre (SIMFC) provides outreach programs and nutrition to the needy in the downtown core. SIMFC is a corporate member of Nutana Rotary and is represented at our meetings by Will Grant who works at SIMFC. Lorne presented a \$1000 cheque to Will for SIM-FC's use on their breakfast program. Will expressed thanks from SIMFC for the continued support of their programs. In the past year they have distributed 10,000 breakfasts. Everyone has suffered through the pandemic but Saskatoon Nutana Rotary has shown they care throughout.

Jack Scott thanked Darren and Will.

Lorne, Candace, Jim Gillis and Jim Blackburn related their respective experiences at the virtual District conference this past weekend. They all had favorite presentations but were unanimous in their praise in how well the conference was run and how well the spirit of a live conference was captured.

Asit questioned the members about various aspects of the AfroCanadian experience in Canada. Except for Bob Devrome, we all were shown to be poorly informed about the black experience in Sakatchewan and were fined accordingly.
