**Program** - Darren Fradette - St. Frances Cree Bilingual School



Principal Darren Fradette of St. Frances Cree Bilingual School welcomed us to the school's Bateman Crescent Campus. Grade 7 student Hayden led us in a prayer in the Cree language. The Mahikanak (Wolf) Drum Group, under the direction of Elder Elmer Tootosis, performed. In his remarks, Principal Fradette reported that registration at St. Frances Cree Bilingual School's MacPherson and Bateman campuses has grown to 630 this year. The school hopes that funding for a new school building, to be located at the current Sion School campus at Grosvenor and 7th Street, will be announced in the spring 2020 Saskatchewan budget. If this happens, the new school building should be ready for use in fall 2022.

President Candace presented Darren with a cheque for \$10,000, the final installment in our club's three-year, \$30,000 commitment. The money is used to purchase iPads at a cost of some \$500 each. The school now has a total of some 200 iPads - 6 for each classroom. They contain apps that are used by students for language, literature and math instruction. Darren expressed the school's deep appreciation for our support.

We enjoyed a meal of soup and bannock, catered by Micisotan Restaurant, located in the Peace Hills Trust Building, 103C Packham Ave.
