Program - Jack Brodsky and Winston Blake - Restorative Action Program (RAP)



Betty Ann Arscott introduced quest

speakers Jack Brodsky and Winston Blake. Jack is the board chair and Winston the Executive Director of the Restorative Action Program (RAP). Jack gave some background on RAP which was started 16 years ago by the Rotary Club of Saskatoon in response to an appeal from Mount Royal High School. Since then, all five Rotary clubs have become part of RAP and it has grown to serve nine city high schools. Winston then took over to talk more specifically about how RAP helps Saskatoon youth. RAP uses the Prevention, Intervention and Reconnection (PIR) model to help students deal with issues such as bullying and conflict. RAP facilitators help students solve such problems without becoming involved in the criminal justice system. Last year RAP had direct contact with 8,000 Saskatoon youth, with 44% of the referrals coming from the students themselves.
