Program - Don Atchison - World Trade Centre



Ed Pek introduced former Mayor Don Atchison, who is now a senior consultant with Canwest Commercial and Land Corp. Don spoke about the company's plans to build a 9 storey, 122,000 square foot, \$55 million World Trade Centre office tower in downtown Saskatoon. Construction will begin in winter or spring 2018, with the building to be complete by June 2020. The new building will join a network of 325 WTCs in 89 countries around the world. WTCs vary from city to city, but typically include businesses involved in areas such as international trade, finance, law, accounting and economic development. The Saskatoon WTC will strive to attract a strong agricultural component. Kim Horan thanked Don for his presentation.
