OPENING

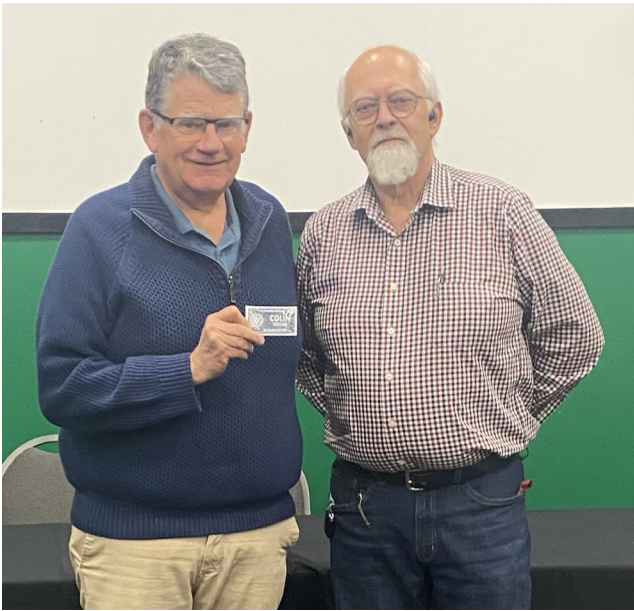

PROGRAM

Jim Blackburn introduced our speaker, Darren Bohmann. Darren has been a teacher for 32 years and is retiring this fall. He has been involved with the Restorative Action Program(RAP) for 18 years and currently the RAP Co-ordinator for Saskatoon.

RAP place facilitators in schools to help students resolve conflicts and more importantly teach skills to help students resolve conflicts themselves.

School Administrators report that where RAP is involved school suspensions are reduced and their job becomes easier.

Presently 14,000 students have RAP availability in 14 high schools. All of the Catholic schools are covered, with 2 public schools remaining to get RAP.

Interventions in the past year are up 16% so RAP is needed more than ever. Social media abuse seems to be the main cause of conflicts. RAP is funded 50% by the school boards and 50% by fund raising. One of the fund raising initiatives is a crew neck sweater with student art. If interested go to <http://rapsaskatoon.org/> for purchase details.
