# PROGRAM

Hyunjung Shin introduced our speakers, Michelle Monroy-Valle and Johanna Bergerman from Saskatoon Breast Feeding



One of the organization's goals is to close the gaps for immigrants, and aboriginals

They are a community based non profit group. Worked together for over 30 years. Michelle has worked with mothers and babies for over 15 years.

Johanna and her family story. She said you tend to be hard on yourself if you can't when you're trying to breastfeed. Lactation consultant would tell you if the baby is fussing they are either hungry or cold. The delivery was 11 days late. A 3rd year student showed her how to

breastfeed. At first the latch was brief. She read a making milk brochure. The baby was agitated in the evening and was not responding, and became almost inconsolable. Her milk came in three days after birth, but could not get her to latch. Number of things tried until she finally got the way of it. At 4 weeks a language pathologist determined there was a tongue tied issue. Once procedure was completed everything started to work normally.

About 95% of the time. 40% of newborns were supplementary fed within first days. Baby friendly initiative to support women to be more successful with breast feeding. Working to get the hospitals to pay for the formula so it isn't as freely given out in the hospital. Giving out the formula in hospital undermined the breastfeeding initiative. Logos for breastfeeding are posted where ever it is safe to feed their baby. Once mothers are good with breastfeeding they want to do their normal things. They are working to make buses become breastfeeding locations. They are working to make breastfeeding more inclusive for people from other countries. The Saskatoon Mother Centre provides support for Indigenous women.
