We were led in “O Canada” and our “4 Way Test Song” by YouTube videos.

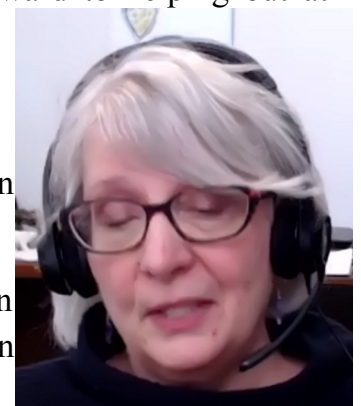

Peggy Clark introduced Faith Bodnar, Executive Director of the Canadian Mental Health Association(CMHC) Saskatchewan Branch as our guest speaker.

Faith obtained her university education at the University of Alberta. She began her working life in Lloydminster AB, and continued working throughout western



Canada for non-profit advocacy groups. She has been able to contribute to local, provincial, national and international work regarding human rights and vulnerable people. As an Executive Director of two provincial advocacy organizations and now as the ED of Saskatoon, Faith believes in full inclusion, equality, social and economic justice and the right to access services.

Saskatoon is her home and she loves living here.

The title of the presentation is COVID FATIGUE.

CMHC began in Saskatoon in 1948. Its current annual budget is \$1.3m. \$600,000 of its income is grants for services provided and the remainder is raised through fund raising activities.

COVID and the effects of COVID have effected everyone and everyone in different ways. Generally the most affected people were the folks who were most disadvantaged prior to the onset of COVID.
