He discussed the tremendous changes that have occurred in train traffic over the years including robot engines, elimination of the caboose, move from coal fired steam to diesel/electric, 55 lb rails to 150 lb rails and hauling 240 cars of potash to Vancouver to identify a few. The track speed on the main lines is now 60 MPH with 30 MPH on the branch lines. He described some of his unique experiences and noted that the freight trains make money but not so with the passenger trains.
