# **PROGRAM**

The program today was a video presentation by Dave Garvie about his Rotary club in San Carlos.

Dave is a native to Saskatoon having taken all of his schooling in Saskatoon including post secondary. Most of his working life was in Calgary. Upon retirement Dave and family spend most of their time in San Carlos, He has been a Rotarian in San Carlos for 12 years. The club has 32 members, 2/3 of which are seasonal. (Canadian and American).

The clubs primary project focus is youth education. They have built 3 schools in San Carlos. They do about 4 fund raisers a year. Most of the fund raisers are food catering, type events. Another event is called cow plop bingo. An area is marked out into about 3000 squares(target area). The squares are sold. A bovine is turned loose into the target area and given a specific time to make a deposit. Once the deposit is made the coordinates of the plop are determined. The owner of the deed to the despoiled square wins a sum of money. Might be fun. We have some caballeros to wrangle the cows in Stan and his Wonder Horse and Karol and Peanut but we would need more. Dave answered questions and was thanked by Candace.
