Brenda has been a frequent visitor to our club and always provides inspiration as to what it means to be a Rotarian.

Brenda and fellow Rotarian Eva Vita from Winnipeg are endeavouring to raise funds for the Rotary Annual Fund in aid of District projects. As we are aware all funds donated to the Annual fund are available to the District for project grants after three years. It is therefore essential that funds are raised for the Annual Fund.

Between Jan 1st and March 16th (75 day Challenge)Brenda will walk the distance equivalent to the distance from Saskatoon to each club

in Saskatchewan (1500 km) and Eva will do the equivalent bike riding for each club in Manitoba and Northern Manitoba. Brenda and Eva can not do this alone so each club is challenged to form a team and walk and bike to help them achieve the goal.

Members can raise funds by seeking pledges for each km travelled or a lump sum. In January Brenda walked 400.74 km. So form a group and help out.

Brenda advised that in 2021 there 5 cases of wild polio in the world, 1 in Pakistan and 4 in Afghanistan. Since the unrest in Afghanistan last August the current polio numbers are uncertain. In Afghanistan women were doing the inoculations but the Taliban tend to frown on that sort of thing.

On behalf of the club Betty Ann Arscott thanked Brenda for her continuing hard work for Rotary.
