## PROGRAM.

Jim Blackburn introduced Ulf Bergmann. Ulf is a researcher from Stockholm in the pharmacology area and is a world authority in his specialty. Ulf came to Saskatoon to work with Jim in 1980. Jim lectured in Stockholm in 1990. The Blackburns and Bergmanns continued their friendship thru the years. While Ulf was in Saskatoon Jim introduced him to Rotary through a visit to the Nutana Rotary club. This sparked an interest for Ulf and now Ulf and his spouse Mia are both Rotary members. Ulf's Zoom presentation was "Saving the Baltic" which is multi-country, multi- Rotary club effort for projects that have the goal of cleaning up the Baltic Sea.

The Baltic Sea is 3000 years old which is recent by geologic standards. The sea has 3000 km of coastline in 9 countries. The catchment area contains 90m people in 13 countries. It is relatively shallow at an average depth of 60m.

Ulf went on to tell us of the activities of BASRAN. BASRAN stands for Baltic Sea (Regional) Action Network of Rotarians. BASRAN includes several Districts from three Rotary Zones, 15, 17 & 18. A network of voluntary Rotarians enthusiastic about improving the state of the Baltic Sea.
