PROGRAM.

Walt Pawlovich introduced Tanya Baran. Tanya Baran is a third generation Ukrainian Canadian who lives in Saskatoon. She is a registered nurse with a husband and three daughters. In the past year she has been to the Ukraine three times and plans to go again later in February. She is a member of Ukrainian Patriot and when in the Ukraine works under their auspices.

Ukrainian Patriot

Ukrainian Patriot is a group of Ukrainians and internationals working to aid volunteers defending Ukraine and those civilians caught in the crossfire. They are on the ground delivering medical, humanitarian and protective support to civilians volunteers and defenders in the form of protective gear, medicine, food bags, "grab bags" for children, hygiene kits, food and shelter for abandoned pets, while taking as many people as they can to safety. Presentation

The members were moved by Tanya's description of her experiences while in the Ukraine. She was in the eastern area, parts of which had been subject to Russian occupation, retaken by Ukrainian forces and now being heavily shelled and "droned" by Russian forces. She went into dangerous areas where other aid groups will not go. Tanya is the designated medical lead for Ukrainian Patriot and is responsible for ensuring the medical supplies are of the highest quality possible. Tanya was in harms way when rocket strikes were very close to her location. Prior to her trips to the Ukraine Tanya collects enough medical supplies to fill several bags. These bags are her luggage.

Asit gave a heartfelt thanks to Tanya on behalf of the club.
