PROGRAM.

President Peggy introduced member Hannah Ebole Enti-Brown who presented a proposal for a club funded project in Ghana.

The title of her presentation was “Wash Project for the Kalbeo Community in the upper East Region, Ghana”. Kalbeø is a farming community with a population of 2000. Farming is practiced on a small scale due to poor soil and water scarcity. This is a deprived community due to lack of social and health services and there is poor knowledge of good sanitation practices.

The current water supply is 3 to 4 km from the village. Hauling the water is the responsibility of the women and children. The village lacks toilet facilities leading to potential exposure to disease due to lack of hygiene knowledge.

The project of installing wells and associated distribution aims to improve the health and well being of the community and create a cleaner and more sustainable environment for all.

Hannah then presented a detailed project proposal for the execution of the project in 12 months with the involvement of partner clubs. The proposal included community engagement, objectives, components, timelines, partnerships, budget, sustainability and expected outcomes and impacts.

The Board committed to considering this proposal at their next meeting.

Joe Dierker commended Hannah for her excellent presentation on behalf of the club.
